

EAGLE'S WINGS RESIDENT RULES (WOMEN)

General House Guidelines / Daily Routines

1. **Housekeeping**– Each individual will help maintain the house by picking up after themselves. Chores will be routinely assigned by staff. This includes sweeping and mopping the floors, cleaning the oven and stove, cleaning the showers and toilets, and so on. Staff may enter and inspect the unit at any time during the program. Residents are responsible for any damage to the house or its furnishings.

Special note: Feminine hygiene products must be wrapped and put in the trash can. **DO NOT FLUSH DOWN THE COMODE!!!
2. **Security**- The house should be secured each evening by curfew. Curfew is 10:00 p.m. Sunday-Thursday nights. On Friday and Saturday nights, the curfew is 11:00 p.m. Lights are to be out from the appropriate curfew time until 6:00 a.m. Employment or a pass is the only exception to this rule. If you are not working past these hours and come in after the set curfew without previous arrangements, you will be given a written warning. All residents are required to sleep within their designated sleeping quarters.
3. **Guests**- Guests will be allowed to visit residents during church service times which are Wednesday night at 6 p.m. and on Sunday morning at 11 a.m. at Love's Crossing Church of God. Guests can also visit on Thursday night Fellowship Night from 7-9 p.m. at the men's facility. Visitation on Saturday is from Noon to 6:00 p.m. No guests are allowed in the sleeping quarters. **All visits must be approved by a staff member prior to the visit.**
4. **Smoking**- Absolutely no smoking permitted inside the house. We encourage abstinence, but if you do smoke on the property outside, do not throw butts on the ground. Use proper receptacles.
5. **Alcohol/Drugs**- Residents are not allowed to use alcohol, illegal drugs or misuse of prescription drugs either on or off the property while residing at Eagle's Wings. Staff will perform random drug tests as well as after residents return after any weekend pass. If the test is positive, staff will recommend an appropriate drug treatment facility and the resident will be asked to leave immediately.
6. **Physical/Verbal Abuse**- Physical and verbal abuse is not allowed at Eagle's Wings. If you are having difficulty with how you deal with negative feelings, staff will try to help you learn better coping skills.
7. **Weekend Passes**- A weekend (48-HOUR) pass may be taken after the first 30 days of residency. Only two passes allowed per month and a pass cannot be taken on the 3rd weekend unless approved by staff. You will be granted a pass ONLY if you meet ALL three of the following conditions:
 - Employment has been established.
 - Resident is current with fees.
 - A written request must be turned in and **approved** by staff no later than Wednesday at 5pm for the weekend of the pass requested.
 - A \$20 fee for a drug screen must also be turned in prior to leaving on pass. **NO EXCEPTIONS.**

8. **Personal clothing and other items** – With limited space available for each resident, please limit your clothes to a reasonable amount. You will be assigned closet space and a small plastic drawer chest. You may also purchase an underbed drawer to store some items. It should take no more than half the length of the bed so as to fit two under the bed (half for the upper and half for the lower bed occupant).

Residents are totally responsible for all personal belongings, including but not limited to medications, ID's, money, personal appliances, etc. Residents may obtain their own personal lock box for such items. **(Lock boxes are subject to random searches)**

Laundry - Each resident should only wash and dry full loads. No partial loads. This will assist with water and power conservation. If needed, the house manager will provide a schedule for wash days for each resident.

9. **Daily routine for unemployed**– See staff for job search requirements.
10. **Animals**– Pets will not be allowed.
11. **Phones**- Personal cellphones are allowed after the first 30 days but must have the app Life360 installed and active at all times. Deactivating may be grounds for dismissal.
12. **Thermostats**– Thermostats will be kept within the following guidelines.
- Summer (Air conditioning) – Not below 70 degrees
 - Winter (Heat) – Not above 72 degrees
13. **Television** - Viewing times are from 6 p.m. until nightly curfew. Programming must to be approved by a member of Eagle's Wings staff.
14. **Social Media**- Absolutely no pictures are allowed to be placed onto social media that contains other residents of the program.
15. **Physical Contact** - No resident is allowed to have physical contact with anyone other than a family member(s). (ie., hugging, hand holding etc.)

The Eagle's Wings program founder, program director(s) or Board of Directors may amend these rules at any time. (See Client Agreement)
